



ABOUT IBCEx'23

9th International Biotechnology Competition and Exhibition (IBCEx 2023) is an annual program organized by Bioprocess Engineering Student Society (BIOSS), from Faculty of Chemical and Energy Engineering, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, Johor Bahru, Johor.

Bringing the concept of IBCEx from 2015 until 2022 towards a bigger leap, this program is organized to provide a great opportunity for students from various institutions (local and international) to compete and exhibit their creative innovations in biotechnology throughout this competition. This program has three competitions: Innovation Project Competition, Poster Competition and Video Competition. Different with the previous three years, IBCEx'23 will be conducted physically to attract young talents to participate this program.

It is our hope that this program will give more and better contribution towards the development of biotechnology industry especially in Malaysia by giving exposure and encouraging more potential students to participate in any biotechnology competition in this globalization era. We also hope that this event can introduce and further promote BIOSS and UTM at both local and international levels.





OBJECTIVE

- To provide opportunities for local and international participants to introduce their innovations and further enhance their knowledge in the field of biotechnology to achieve National Biotechnology Policy 2.0 including agricultural biotechnology and food security; healthcare and wellbeing; and biotechnology in industrialization and circular economy.

- 3. To help committee members improve their soft skills (such as communication, teamwork, and problem-solving skill).
- 4. To establish new collaborative relationships between BIOSS, UTM and other companies or universities who share common passion and interest in the field of biotechnology, and
- 5. To promote and uphold Universiti Teknologi Malaysia as one of the research universities in Malaysia in the field of science and technology by inviting the public to attend the event.


Besides, a forum will be organized throughout this program by inviting academicians or engineers from various industries to share their knowledge and experience related to our theme.

The events during IBCEx 2023 will comprise of Innovation Project Competition, Poster Competition, Video Competition, Exhibition, Forum and Day Trip.









ACTIVITIES' DETAILS









INNOVATION PROJECT COMPETITION

Introduction

Innovation Project Competition is the main competition of IBCEx'23. With the theme "Youth Awakening: Ways to Sustainable World", the innovation project is opened to Undergraduate and Postgraduate students from local and international university. This competition will be held physically in Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, UTM Skudai, Johor. The categories of the innovation project are Waste Treatment, Biotechnology and Green Technology. The innovation could be in health care and pharmaceuticals, fermentation technology, food and drinks innovations, energy and environment management or any other types of the innovation related to biotechnology and green environment.

All the participants are welcomed to attend the competition physically with the innovation project in UTM. For **Day 1** (5th **May 2023**) of the competition, which is the first round of the competition, all the participants will set up their booth along with their prototype and presenting materials. Each team will present their product to the juries for 8 minutes and 5 minutes for the QnA session. For **Day 2** (6th **May 2023**) of the competition, which is the final round of the competition, three groups from each category will be selected and present for 8 minutes and 3 minutes for QnA session The slides are the only presentation materials that can be brought.





Upon registration, the innovation project competition can be made up of a team with maximum 3 persons. Chaperone is a person who supervises the team. He/she could be the lecturer or supervisor of the project or team. All the participants should fill in the registration form which can be downloaded from the google form link and fill in the form with all the information needed. Only one (1) representative from the team who can be the leader or one of the members from the team to fill in the google form. One (1) scanned copy of student ID of each participant and one (1) scanned copy of the transaction slip with full payment are needed to be uploaded in the google form.

The accommodation for participants is not included in the registration fee. However, the accommodation can be provided by organiser and participants need to inform the organiser before 15th March 2023. Once the registration of participants is confirmed, a detail about the accommodation will be sent to the participant as reference. Besides, a day trip will be organised by the organiser after the Day 2 of the competition and more information will be given after registration of participants is confirmed.





TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. The competition is open to all **local and international undergraduate (UG)** and **postgraduate (PG)** students from any field of study.
- 1.2. Each participation is allowed for a **maximum of three (3) members per team and one (1) advisor/chaperone**.
- 1.3. All members of the team should represent the same educational institution.
- 1.4. There is **no limitation on the number of participating teams** from the same educational institution.

2. COMPETITION

- 2.1. Only **1 entry** in any category is allowed for **each participating team**.
- 2.2. The competition consists of **4 categories**:
 - a. [UG] Biotechnology
 - b. [UG] Waste Treatment
 - c. [UG] Green Technology
 - d. [PG] Biotechnology / Waste Treatment / Green Technology
- 2.3. All participating teams are required to set up their own booth along with the prototype for the exhibition purpose.





- 2.4. All participating teams are required to **prepare a presentation slide and a brochure/poster** for the innovative products.
- 2.5. The **brochure/poster and presentation slide** will be used in the **presentation of innovative products session** in the competition.
- 2.6. The competition will be held in **2 rounds**:

1st round

All participating teams are required to present their innovative product at their booth. The question and answer (Q&A) sessions will be conducted by the panel of judges.

2nd round

3 selected teams in each category **from the 1**st **round** are required to do **slide presentations** on the innovative product. The question and answer (Q&A) sessions will be conducted by the panel of judges.

- 2.7. Every participating team must prepare and present their innovative product, based on the following details:
 - a. **Objective** of the innovation product
 - **b.** Materials used for making the innovative product
 - **c. Method** for preparing the innovation product
 - **d. Impact** of the innovation product
 - e. **Problem** in making the innovative product
 - **f.** Ways to **improve** the innovation product
- 2.8. The innovation product must be **original**, **creative**, and **related to the theme** of IBCEx 2023 which is **"Youth Awakening: Ways to Sustainable World"**.





- 2.9. The **cost** for the preparation of the innovation product will be **fully covered by the participating team**.
- 2.10. The innovative product will be judged based on the following criteria:
 - a. Originality and creativity of the idea proposed (new idea or adaptation idea).
 - b. Design of the innovation product (materials used, user-friendly, accuracy of information).
 - c. Impact of the innovation product (individual, community, economic growth, green environment).
 - d. Improvement of the innovation product (can be improved, problems can be overcome).
 - e. Presentation (the use of visual, oral communication and effective public speaking, detailed presentation).
- 2.11. The organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry that is believed does not meet the eligibility requirements, objectives, and rules in this competition.
- 2.12. Internet access **will not be provided**. All participating teams are advised to bring their own mobile broadband or other devices for easier Internet access.
- 2.13. The appointment of the panel of judges for this competition is the sole responsibility of the organizer.
- 2.14. All decisions made by the judges are **final** and **appeal is not allowed.**
- 2.15. The **winning teams from each of the categories** will receive a **gift**, **cash prize**, and **certificates**.





- 2.16. The **Best Innovation team** will be awarded a **gift, cash prize** and **certificate**.
- 2.17. The **Best Presenter** will be awarded a **gift**, **cash prize** and **certificate**.
- 2.18. The **Best Booth** will be awarded a **gift**, **cash prize**, and **certificate**.
- 2.19. The **Best Brochure** will be awarded with a **gift**, **cash prize** and **certificate**.
- 2.20. Every participating team will receive participation **certificates** and **souvenir.**



Upon registration, each of the participants needs to fill the registration Google Form link and fill the form with the information needed. All the participants should upload the poster and video presentation through the Google Form link provided.

The result of the poster competition will be announced in the closing ceremony through Facebook live. However, participants are encouraged to attend our event at UTM, Skudai.





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 Open to all high school, matriculation, foundation, preuniversity and diploma students from IPTA/IPTS in **Malaysia** or any **other countries**.
- 1.2 Only **one** entry is allowed for each participant as this is an **individual competition.**

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1 To engage the community's interest and raise awareness about sustainable innovations through eye-catching posters.
- 2.2 To provide a platform for the youths to express their view and insight regarding the theme 'Generation Restoration: Ecosystem Restoration for People, Nature, and Climate'.

3. THEME:

'Generation Restoration: Ecosystem Restoration for People, Nature, and Climate'

Over the years, humans never stop plundering Earth's natural resources instead of allowing it to grow prodigiously. According to a UN report, the amount of the planet's natural resources extracted for human use has tripled in 40 years. Hence it is urgent for us to concerning the topic of Ecosystem Restoration to prevent the halt and reserve the degradation of ecosystems worldwide.





4. COMPETITION

- 4.1 There is only one category in this poster contest, which consists of high school, matriculation, foundation, pre-university, and diploma students.
- 4.2 Participants must design a **poster** and **video presentation** with relevant title and must be **original, creative, and related to the theme** of the poster competition IBCEx 2023 which is 'Generation Restoration: Ecosystem Restoration for People, Nature, and Climate'.
- 4.3 Participants may choose one of the topics below or other topics related to the theme.
 - I. Food insecurity
 - **II.** Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation
 - **III. Biodiversity Loss**
- 4.4 Poster must convey the theme and IBCEx 2023 logo must be included in the poster.
- 4.5 Poster Competition will be based on **online assessment**. Evaluation will be carried out in two parts:
 - i. Poster creation
 - ii. Video presentation
- 4.6 The poster **must be in English** and must be the original work of the participant.
- 4.7 Winners will be awarded **certificates** and **cash prizes**. And certificates will be given to all participants.
- 4.8 Every participant needs to pay **RM 20.00(local participant) or USD10(international participant)** and attach the proof of payment (receipt/screenshot) of the registration fees to secure a place in the competition. Registration will not be accepted without proof of payment or if the payment is made after the deadline.





5. RULES AND REGULATION

- 5.1 Softcopy of the poster must be submitted through the submission link before the submission deadline of 3rd April 2023.
- 5.2 Entries received after the submission deadline will not be taken into consideration.

The marks of the competition will be considered through social media likes, comments and shared.

Upon registration, each of the participants needs to fill the registration Google Form link and fill the form with the information needed. All the participants should upload the poster and video presentation through the Google Form link provided.

The result of the poster competition will be announced in the closing ceremony through Facebook live. However, participants are encouraged to attend our event at UTM, Skudai.





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all high school, matriculation, foundation, preuniversity, and diploma students from IPTA/IPTS in Malaysia or any other countries.
- 1.2 It is an **individual** competition. Every participant is allowed to submit only one entry.

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1 To provide a platform and great opportunity for participants to show their creativity and skills via video contests.
- 2.2 To share their view and opinion related to the theme "Global Health Crisis: Noncommunicable disease"

3. THEME

"Global Health Crisis: Noncommunicable disease"

Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) including heart disease, diabetes, and many more are the leading cause of mortality in the world. This invisible epidemic is an underappreciated cause of poverty and hinders the economic development of many countries. The risk of getting noncommunicable diseases could be increased by an unhealthy lifestyle such as alcoholism, smoking, unhealthy diet, and so on. **Suggest ways to arise the concern of the public about the noncommunicable diseases can be reduced.**





4. COMPETITION

- 4.1 There is only **one category** in this competition which consists of high school, matriculation, foundation, pre-university, and diploma students.
- 4.2 Participants create a video with a relevant title and must be **original, creative, and related to the theme** of the Video competition IBCEx 2023 which is **"Global Health Crisis:** Noncommunicable disease"
- 4.3 The **content of the video** must include:
 - i. The main cause of non-communicable diseases in Malaysia
 - ii. The impact of non-communicable diseases in many aspects.
 - iii. Ideas/suggestions/actions to arise the concern of the public about the noncommunicable disease.
 - iv. Ideas/suggestions/actions to reduce the risk of getting non-communicable diseases.
- 4.4 All entries must be participants' original works. Thus, not any part or components are copied from others' works.

4.5 Language spoken must be **fully in English** accompanied by **English subtitles.**

4.6 Every participant needs to pay **RM 20.00** and attach the proof of payment (receipt/screenshot) of the registration fee to secure a place in the competition. Registration will not be accepted without proof of payment or if the payment is made after the deadline.





5. VIDEO EVALUATION

- 5.1 Marks allocation will be based on the online voting results and evaluation from judges.
- 5.2 Video competition will be based on online assessment. Evaluation will be based on:
 - i. Creativity
 - ii. Inspiration
 - iii. Content of the video
 - iv. Appropriation to the theme
- 5.3 All the submissions will be uploaded on the IBCEx2023 social media page (Facebook, Instagram, and LinkedIn) by the organizer for the online voting session.
- 5.4 Online voting session:
 - i. Based on the number of likes and shares on social media (Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn).
 - ii. The online voting session will be lasting for 2 weeks (10th 24th April 2023)
 - iii. Any additional likes and shares after the online voting session will not be considered.
- 5.5 Judges' decisions are **final, conclusive, and binding**. No further appeal, enquiry or correspondence will be entertained.
- 5.6 Winners will be awarded certificates and cash prizes
- 5.7 Certificate will be given to all participants.





6. VIDEO FORMAT

- 6.1 Video entries should consist of:
 - i. Theme of the Video Competition IBCEx2023 "Global Health Crisis: Noncommunicable disease"
 - ii. Appropriate title of the video related to the theme given in (i).
 - iii. Brief synopsis of the video.
- 6.2 The duration of the video must not be exceeding 5 minutes (excluding credits). 5 points will be deducted after every 30 seconds. Any video entry with a duration length of 6 minutes and above will not be disqualified.
- 6.3 The recommended video format is Mp4 format with minimum recommended video resolution of 720p: 1280 x 720.
- 6.4 Audio quality must be clear. On-site audio feed or narration is allowed.

7. RULES AND REGULATION

- 7.1 Softcopy of the video must be submitted through the submission link before the submission deadline of 3rd April 2023.
- 7.2 Entries received after the submission deadline will not be taken into consideration.
- 7.3 The organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry which does not meet the eligibility requirements, objectives, and rules of the competition.





- 7.4 Videos that are offensive and contain inappropriate content will be disqualified without any prior notice.
- 7.5 Judges' decisions are final, conclusive, and binding. No further appeal, enquiry or correspondence will be entertained.


