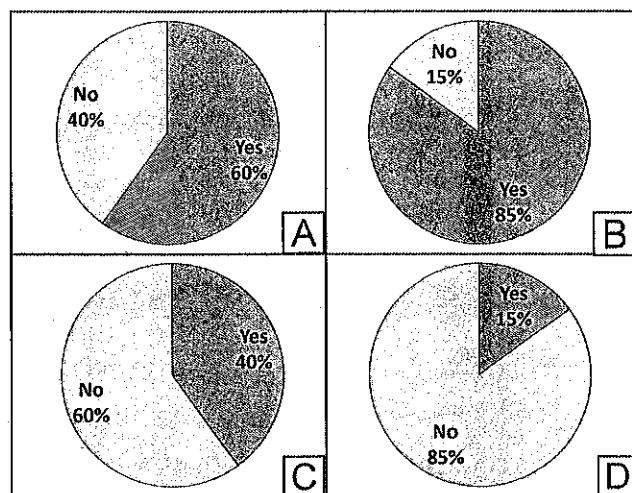


### Part A 2%

Look at the pictures below. For each question, you will hear a short conversation or talk. Choose the picture (A, B, C, or D) that best matches the conversation or talk.

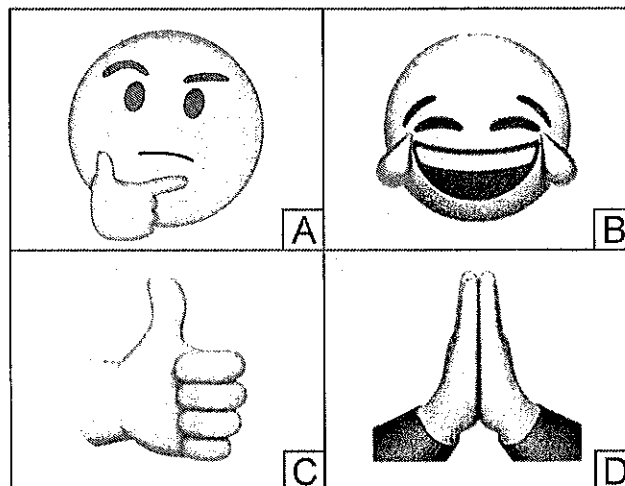
#### Question 1

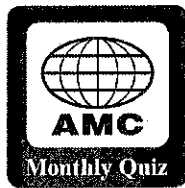
